## Hear from Lehmans' and Woolies' administrators

In a piece in **The Times** this morning, detailing the surge in legal work from the all the administrations we've seen in recent months, two high profile exponents of the art are identified: Tony Lomas of PricewaterhouseCoopers (who is working on Lehmans) and Deloitte's Neville Kahn (working on Woolworths).

I would agree. Lehmans is the biggest and most complicated administration the world has ever seen, while dismantling as iconic a brand of Woolies has brought considerable attention to Kahn.

Last week he was also involved in the administration of Mosaic - the fashion retail group that comprises Oasis, Warehouse, Karen Millen and Principles among others - and the use of a pre-pack saw all but Principles and The Shoe Studio sold to management.
